Students earn awards based on our school values of being a safe, respectful learner to progress through a three-tiered award system (bronze, sliver, gold, PBL medal) - this will be adjusted based on the student's current year level. PBL reward days will be a celebration of students' commitment to following our school expectations.



Students are responsible for collecting their assembly awards that they earn throughout the year. When your child has received a bundle of 5 awards, they are to bring them to their classroom teacher. They will then be signed by an executive staff member who will return them to your child. Your child when then receive a special PBL award at the next assembly.
