How will it work?

- In Raymond Terrace The Village runs one day a week with child minding crèche included
- At Kurri Kurri Community Centre included with The Village is Kindy Development, a childcare program developed to assist your children in achieving developmental milestones for their age, in a friendly, fun, supportive and inclusive environment one day a week
- Includes the gaining of a Certificate II in Skills for Work and Vocational Pathways
- Assistance with creation of cover letter & resume and interview skills

What learners can expect:

A small learning environment with peer support

Speakers and demonstrations

Support to complete a Certificate II in Skills for Work and create pathways to further study and employment

Learning fundamental hospitality skills

The opportunity and support to grow and reach potential

Assistance with links to other services in the community



Project Objectives, participants will:

- Develop a more solid understanding of their own work and life goals
- Develop an understanding of basic workplace skills and teamwork with hands on hospitality experience
- Complete a Certificate II in Skills for Work and Vocational Pathways
- Create learning pathways for future employment prospects and assistance with resumes, cover letters and interview skills
- Have opportunities for group and one on one discussions and support
