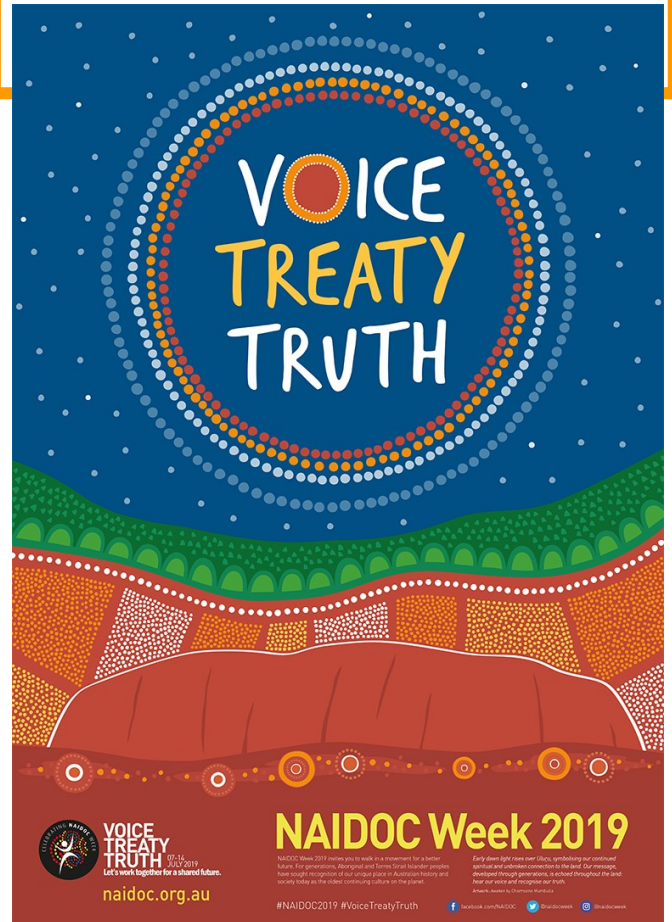
Wear striped or colourful socks and bring along a gold coin donation in support of people and their families living with Cri du Chat.
